



## A practical guide to making your flipbook

This guide gathers a few practical tips for anyone who has just bought a flipbook on cineografo.com.

**1** Once you receive the compressed .zip file you need to extract it, so that all the pages to be printed come out.

**2** Print the pictures contained in the extracted folder. You can print them at home or take the file to any local print shop or photo printing service. Photo paper is an excellent material for making a flipbook.

**3** Cut out all the frames contained in the printed pages. Every frame has a white area with a small number on it. The white area is where the binding goes, and the number is what you will use in the next step to assemble the flipbook in the right order.





**4** Stack the frames one on top of the other, ordering them by the small number printed in the white area of each frame. Line them up carefully and bind the flipbook with a heavy duty stapler.



Instead of a stapler, a good idea is a bulldog clip like the one in the picture: they cost very little and the final result is excellent!
